

Integrated five year BS/Masters Program- The combined Baccalaureate Master's Program in the College of Engineering and technology is designed to provide an exceptional opportunity for suitably qualified students to obtain dual undergraduate and graduate degrees in mechanical engineering in five years after graduating from high school. This program requires students to register for at least six credits of the graduate courses in their senior year that are applied to both the undergraduate and graduate degrees. As a result, a student enrolled in the program is able to complete the Master's degree by taking 24 additional credits of graduate course work instead of 30 credits normally required for the Master's degree.

Freshman students with a minimum high school GPA of 3.0 and SAT score of at least 1100 are eligible for consideration for this program. Junior transfer students admitted into the program must have an overall GPA of 3.0 or better in all the course work attempted at the college(s) from which they are transferring.
